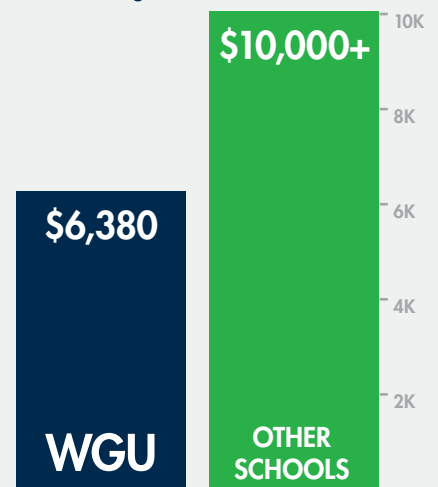
TUITION REIMBURSEMENT BENEFITS
