Institutional Authorization

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Mississippi do so through the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. *Advanced programs are for already licensed teachers who want to add an additional teaching area or field to their licenses (or a separate license for Educational Leadership). These programs are not intended for aspiring teachers seeking initial licensure.

Mississippi Educators may add Supplemental Endorsements to their license by either passing the appropriate Praxis content exam, completing a state-approved program, or completing 21 credits in the new area. Different requirements apply to different endorsement areas. Refer to the [licensure handbook](#) for more information.

The following programs are not available in Mississippi:

- *BS Mathematics Education (Middle Grades)* – This program is not available for initial licensure as Mississippi offers certification in Middle Grades Mathematics as a supplemental endorsement only.
- *MAT Mathematics Education (Middle Grades)* – This program is not available for initial licensure as Mississippi offers certification in Middle Grades Mathematics as a supplemental endorsement only.
- *BS Science Education (Middle Grades)* – This program is not available for initial licensure as Mississippi offers certification in Middle Grades Science as a supplemental endorsement only.
- *BS Science Education (Secondary Earth Science)* – Mississippi does not have an Earth Science license.
- *MA Science Education (Secondary Earth Science)* – Mississippi does not have an Earth Science license.
