Institutional Authorization

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in New Hampshire do so through the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. **Applicants for the ESOL endorsement must complete at least two semesters in a foreign language. This coursework must be completed outside of WGU.

[^]To become licensed as a principal in New Hampshire, candidates must have five years of experience as an educator.
