

DICKIES ARENA POLICIES

GUEST SERVICES

Guest Services is located on the main plaza concourse across from Section 117. Trained Guest Services professionals are readily available to assist guests with any needs. Please stop by for more information regarding Dickies Arena events, directions, or assistance.

EMT/FIRST AID

Trained Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) will be available to assist guests at all events. First Aid is located on the Plaza Level across from section 117; however, EMTs are mobile and can assist anywhere in the building.

Dickies Arena is equipped with Automatic External Defibrillators (AED), which have been placed throughout the building. Designated staff members, including EMT staff, have been properly trained on how to operate the AED. If assistance is needed, contact a staff member immediately.

GUEST SEATING

Seating is first-come, first-served. Guests should be seated with their cell phones on silent before the ceremony begins. Guests should remain in their seats during the entire ceremony as a courtesy to graduates and other guests.

PARKING

Please park in the YELLOW lots or in the CHEVROLET GARAGE.

Parking is \$20 per vehicle.

CONCESSIONS

Dickies Arena offers a wide variety of menu offerings and service styles throughout the arena. Outside food and beverages are not permitted. Guests with specific dietary needs due to medical conditions or religious requirements should email us at accessibility@dickiesarena.com to learn of available offerings and/or coordinate special food entry options. Containers such as bottles, cans, thermoses, or coolers are prohibited from entering the building, except plastic baby bottles containing formula.

LOST CHILDREN

Guests are encouraged to register their child in the Missing Guest Prevention Program before the start of the event at Guest Services in Section 117. Each participating child will be given a bracelet containing parent/guardian contact information. Lost children/guests should be directed to the Guest Services office located on the concourse at Section 117. Parents/guardians looking for a lost guest should reach out to a member of the Dickies Arena Guest Services and Security team immediately.

BAG POLICY

All guests and bags are subject to search. Bags are not to exceed 12" x 6" x 12".

A clear tote, small purse, small fashion backpack, small clutch, plastic storage bags, and drawstring bags are acceptable if they don't exceed the size of 12" x 6" x 12".

Graduates and guests are encouraged not to bring bags with them to the event.

DICKIES ARENA POLICIES

MOTHERS' LOUNGE

Nursing mothers' rooms are available at all arena events. To utilize the nursing rooms located across from Sections 117 and 217, please notify Guest Services at Section 117 or see a Dickies Arena Guest Services or Security team member. This room is first come, first served and will close at the end of each event. Guests looking to access these spaces can check in at a guest services location, and a representative will assist. Housekeeping team members will be deployed to sanitize the rooms between each guest.

LOST-AND-FOUND ITEMS

Any guest who has lost an item during an event will be directed to Guest Services, located at Section 117. All found items should be returned to the same location or given to any guest service/security team member. Guests inquiring about lost items post-event should call **817-502-0053** or reach out via email at **lostandfound@ dickiesarena.com**. All items not claimed 30 days after the event will be discarded.

ACCESSIBILITY

All Dickies Arena staff are committed to providing a memorable and safe experience for all our guests, including those with disabilities and special needs. If you need assistance during an event, please visit **Guest Services at Section 117** or see any available staff member.

Accessible/disabled seating is available on all levels of Dickies Arena. Accessible seating is reserved for guests with accessibility needs and their companions.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING & ACCESS MAP

Parking for guests displaying a state-issued handicapped placard or license plate is available in all lots. Accessible parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Parking rates apply and may vary in conjunction with the event and/or parking area.

Guests who are seeking ADA parking are encouraged to park in the yellow Lots on Trail Drive. Guests can access an elevator to the left of the southeast circle stairs that will take them to the Simmons Bank Plaza.

See below for accessible routes to all our main entrances:

North Entrance: A wheelchair ramp allows guests to access the north doors when they are dropped off or coming over from the Will Rogers Complex.

East Entrance: The northeast corner of the Simmons Bank Plaza has an elevator to assist disabled guests from the Will Rogers Complex. Guests parking in accessible spaces in the yellow lots have access to an elevator outside the southeast corner of the arena that will bring guests to the Simmons Bank Plaza.

South Entrance: Guests parking in the Chevrolet Garage can utilize the garage elevators to assist them to Level Three, where an accessible pedestrian bridge will lead guests to the south doors at the Simmons Bank Plaza.

West Entrance: The ground-level entry doors are accessible to all guests walking from Montgomery Street or nearby neighborhoods.

DICKIES ARENA POLICIES

SENSORY INCLUSION

Dickies Arena has a Sensory Needs Room, which is located on the northwest corner of the 200 level. This space is available to any guest. Guests looking to access this space can check in at a guest services location (Section 117), and a representative will assist. Housekeeping team members will be deployed to sanitize the rooms in between each guest.

RESTROOMS

All public restrooms are accessible to our guests with disabilities. Accessible family restrooms are also available throughout Dickies Arena.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Animals or pets of any kind are not permitted into Dickies Arena, with the exception of trained service animals and service animals in training for guests with disabilities. Service animals must be leashed at all times unless performing a necessary task for their handler, which requires removing the leash. Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their service animal and for any damages caused by the service animal. An animal relief area is provided in the East Plaza. A guest whose service animal threatens the safety of other guests and/or employees may be asked to escort the animal off the premises. NO SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted inside Dickies Arena, inside the Chevrolet Garage, or 30 feet from any public entrance at any time. This policy includes electronic cigarette devices and vape pens.

ABOUT

Commencement Weekend is a memorable experience for graduates and their loved ones to celebrate their academic achievement. We want our graduates to experience a joyful, rewarding, and distraction-free ceremony that recognizes their hard work and the sacrifices they have made to reach this point. WGU believes that mutually respectful participation by graduates and their guests is the best way to accomplish this shared intention. In preparation for Commencement, WGU has outlined a protocol. Your and your guests' adherence will ensure a positive experience for all.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES

All graduating students wear approved academic attire that includes a cap, gown, and tassel. The official regalia color is navy. We encourage all graduates to wear comfortable yet professional dress attire under their gowns rather than casual clothing. Master's degree graduates will need a hood specific to their degree. Graduates affiliated with an academic honor society may wear society pins or honor cords on their gowns. With the exception of WGU scholarship pins, leis, and corsages, graduates should not wear other items or decoration on their academic regalia.

Take into consideration the following if decorating your cap for commencement: WGU does not allow content on caps that is considered, in WGU's sole discretion, obscene, vulgar, defamatory, hateful, inappropriate, profane, or that might disregard another's copyright or third-party rights. All decorations must lay flat on the cap.

WGU COMMENCEMENT DECORUM POLICY

Please be advised any graduate or guest acting in a disruptive or disrespectful manner at WGU events, as determined by WGU in its sole discretion, may either not be allowed in the venue or may be escorted from the venue.

MILITARY

Graduates who indicate active-duty military or veteran status on their ceremony RSVP form will receive military honor cords at the Graduate Check-in Area.


GRADUATE CHECK-IN PROCEDURE GRADPASS



The week of Commencement, you will be sent an email with a GradPass with your own personal QR code. This code must be available on your device and visible for check-in.

1. Once you receive this email, please take a screenshot so you can easily find and access this QR code.
2. Please make sure your device is with you, your device is charged, and the display is set on the brightest position.
3. When you arrive for check-in, please have your device out with the screen visible for the commencement ambassadors to see.
4. Your GradPass will be scanned before you cross the stage during the ceremony. Please have your GradPass ready to be scanned as you line up to cross the stage.


