Claudia Romo Edelman

Founder & CEO of We Are All Human and "A La Latina" Podcast

A former diplomat and journalist, Claudia is an expert on mobilizing corporations to advance the Social Agenda with a focus on diversity, equity, and inclusion. Her career includes three decades working for the United Nations, UNICEF, the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, and the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees. She has participated in the creation and launch of global frameworks such as the Sustainable Development Goals and Product (RED).

Since 2017, Claudia has served as the Founder and CEO of the We Are All Human Foundation, a non-profit organization devoted to advancing Diversity, Equity and Inclusion focused on unifying the U.S. Hispanic community. We Are All Human has launched several initiatives and frameworks to advance the progress of Latinos by mobilizing Corporate America and increasing Latino perception and representation. We Are All Human partners with more than 300 companies and 100 of the most important Hispanic organizations representing more than 10 million Latinos.

She is the Co-host of the podcast "A La Latina: the playbook to succeed being your authentic self," which unveils success secrets from accomplished Latinas in Corporate America's C-Suite.

Claudia holds a master's degree in political communication from the London School of Economics. She is a speaker, a frequent columnist and has published 9 books to date on Hispanic-related topics. She is the recipient of numerous awards, including People Magazine's 25 Most Influential Latinas, ALPFA's 50 Most Powerful Latinas and, Ellis Island Medal of Honor, Mexicanos Distinguidos. Claudia serves on the boards of Canoo and is in the Advisory Team of Touch Capital.

Claudia has two children, enjoys sports with her husband, and speaks six languages.

Dr. Sorenson is the Founding Director of the Intermountain Healthcare Leadership Institute where he provides executive coaching to senior healthcare leaders around the United States. He is also President and CEO Emeritus of Intermountain Healthcare having served as CEO from 2009 to 2016. Prior to this, Dr. Sorenson acted as chief operating officer for 11 years and worked for decades as a urologic surgeon at the Utah-based, nonprofit hospital system—continuing to perform urologic cancer surgery even after moving into the C-suite.

In addition to his passion for healthcare, Dr. Sorenson has been committed to high quality, affordable education as a pathway to opportunity. He served on WGU's Board of Trustees from 2015 to 2023, spending his final four years as Chair of the Board. Dr. Sorenson earned a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Utah and a Doctor of Medicine from Weill Cornell Medical College at Cornell University. He is a board-certified urologic surgeon, a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, and Adjunct Professor of Surgery at the University of Utah.
