

### **NOW ARENA POLICIES**

#### **GUEST SERVICES**

Guest Services are located outside section 111 on the concourse.

#### **EMT/FIRST AID**

There is one First-Aid station at NOW Arena staffed with Village of Hoffman Estates EMS for select events. The First-Aid station is located on the Main Concourse near Section 112. If you are in need of medical attention, please notify a NOW Arena Guest Services Representative. The NOW Arena staff is trained to call for immediate response and assistance in emergency situations.

#### **GUEST SEATING**

Seating is first-come, first-served. Guests should be seated with their cell phones on silent before the ceremony begins. Guests should remain in their seats during the entire ceremony as a courtesy to graduates and other guests.

The commencement venue allows photos and videos at the ceremony; however, we ask you to take photos from your seat rather than from the aisles due to fire and safety regulations and as a courtesy to other guests. WGU has hired a professional photographer for this event. Images of each graduate and the ceremony will be available online for purchase.

#### **PARKING**

There are 3,200 on-site parking spaces at NOW Arena. There are plenty of handicapped accessible spaces off of Hoffman Blvd, and Pratum Ave. Once on property, parking attendants will direct you to the closest lot. Parking for all Graduation ceremonies is FREE and is available on a first come first serve basis.

#### CONCESSIONS

Select concession stands around the NOW Arena concourse will be open for each ceremony. NOW Arena is a cashless Arena. We do accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, Google Pay, Apple Pay, & Samsung Pay. Outside food and beverage (including alcoholic beverages) are strictly prohibited.

#### **LOST CHILDREN**

Lost children/individuals should be taken to the nearest usher or security guard. If you become separated from your child or guests, please proceed to Guest Services for further assistance.

#### **BAG POLICY**

NOW Arena has implemented a Clear Bag Policy that can be found <u>HERE</u>. A maximum size clear bag of 12"x12"x6" is permitted. Exceptions will be made for medical, family, or childcare bags or small clutches no larger than 4.5"x 6.5".

Graduates and guests are encouraged not to bring bags with them to the events.

#### NO SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the arena, including vapor electronic cigarettes.

#### **LOST AND FOUND ITEMS**

If you have lost an item during an event, please visit Guest Services outside section 111. After an event you may call (847) 649-2270 Monday through Friday 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM. Please leave a voicemail with the item description, date it was lost, and your contact information.

### **NOW ARENA POLICIES**

#### **ACCESSIBILITY**

Guests should use the ADA ramp located west of the main entrance of NOW Arena. Once a guest is inside the arena there will be signage for seating locations and staff will help direct the guest and one companion to an accessible seating section. Accessible seating is located on the concourse level inside the main arena. First-come first-serve accessible seating is available for only the guest with a mobility impairment and one companion. The rest of the party will need to sit in GA seating inside the arena bowl. Medical and Event staff cannot escort patrons to and from their vehicles via wheelchair.

#### **ACCESSIBLE PARKING & ACCESS MAP**

For patrons with mobility needs, ADA parking is available in the East Lot Only. ADA parking is limited, so the Arena will reserve additional spaces adjacent to the ADA parking during graduations; however, space is still limited and provided on a first-come first-served basis.

#### **SENSORY INCLUSION**

Guests who feel overstimulated or overwhelmed may visit the Sensory Room located at Guest Services, on the main concourse.

#### **RESTROOMS**

Restrooms are located on all levels.

#### SERVICE ANIMALS

Only certified service animals or service animals intraining for guests with disabilities are allowed in the arena. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times.

Graduates are encouraged to wear comfortable shoes.


#### **METAL DETECTORS**

#### **ABOUT**

Commencement Weekend is a memorable experience for graduates and their loved ones to celebrate their academic achievement. We want our graduates to experience a joyful, rewarding, and distraction-free ceremony that recognizes their hard work and the sacrifices they have made to reach this point. WGU believes that mutually respectful participation by graduates and their guests is the best way to accomplish this shared intention. In preparation for Commencement, WGU has outlined a protocol. Your and your guests' adherence will ensure a positive experience for all.

#### **ACADEMIC ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES**

All graduating students wear approved academic attire that includes a cap, gown, and tassel. The official regalia color is navy. We encourage all graduates to wear comfortable yet professional dress attire under their gowns rather than casual clothing. Master's degree graduates will need a hood specific to their degree. Graduates affiliated with an academic honor society may wear society pins or honor cords on their gowns. With the exception of WGU scholarship pins, leis, and corsages, graduates should not wear other items or decoration on their academic regalia.

Take into consideration the following if decorating your cap for commencement: WGU does not allow content on caps that is considered, in WGU's sole discretion, obscene, vulgar, defamatory, hateful, inappropriate, profane, or that might disregard another's copyright or third-party rights. All decorations must lay flat on the cap.

# WGU COMMENCEMENT DECORUM POLICY

Please be advised any graduate or guest acting in a disruptive or disrespectful manner at WGU events, as determined by WGU in its sole discretion, may either not be allowed in the venue or may be escorted from the venue.

#### **MILITARY**

Graduates who indicate active-duty military or veteran status on their ceremony RSVP form will receive military honor cords at the Graduate Check-in Area.
