

KFC YUM! CENTER POLICIES

GUEST SERVICES

Guest Services has two locations in the KFC Yum! Center (Box Office in the main lobby and on the Main Concourse Level) to assist patrons regarding general inquiries, seating questions, accessible needs and assistance and information on future events. Guest Services is open when the doors officially open for an event and throughout the event.

EMT/FIRST AID

First Aid is located on the Main Concourse's south-west corner by section 103 and the Upper Concourse's south-west corner by section 304.

GUEST SEATING

Seating is first-come, first-served. Guests should be seated with their cell phones on silent before the ceremony begins. Guests should remain in their seats during the entire ceremony as a courtesy to graduates and other guests. There is no re-entry during events.

PARKING

The KFC Yum! Center offers a multi-level garage parking under the facility operated by the Parking Authority of River City (PARC). However, there are more than 21,000 parking spaces are available within five blocks of the arena. This includes more than 19,000 spaces at parking garages and surface lots and more than 2,200 on-street parking spaces.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be open at The KFC Yum! Center.

LOST CHILDREN

Please alert KFC Yum! Center guest services if a member of your party is lost during an event.

NO SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted inside The KFC Yum! Center or 30 feet from any public entrance at any time. This policy includes electronic cigarette devices and vapors.

BAG POLICY

All bags are subject to search upon entering the arena. Backpacks of any kind, including drawstring, fanny packs, computer bags, and camera bags are prohibited. Please plan accordingly to help facilitate a quick and efficient entry process. Please report suspicious bags to a KFC Yum! Center team member.

Bags no larger than $14'' \times 14'' \times 6''$ will be allowed into the arena for events.

Medical and parenting bags are permitted and subject to search.

Graduates and guests are encouraged not to bring bags with them to the events.

MOTHERS' LOUNGE

Nursing Mother Rooms are located on the Main Concourse and Upper Concourse. A KFC Yum! Center Arena team member can help direct you to the closest location.

LOST-AND-FOUND ITEMS

Items found before, during, or after an event may be given to the KFC Yum! Center Security Office. During an event, please visit Fan Assist to inquire about lost items. Patrons may also contact the facility at (502) 690-9000 to inquire about lost items. The KFC Yum! Center and its staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lost items not claimed within 30 days are donated to local charities.

KFC YUM! CENTER POLICIES

ACCESSIBILITY

The KFC Yum! Center is fully equipped with ADA Accessibility entrances and seating. Any patron who requires hearing or vision assisted seating may contact the KFC Yum! Center Ticket Office at (502) 690-9090. Disabled or elderly patrons that need an ADA accessible entrance may utilize the drop-off area in front of the KFC Yum! Center on Main St. between Second and Third Streets. Patrons will be able to access the main entrance to the facility with the use of the ramps on the Pepsi Plaza.

NAVIGATION FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED

In partnership with the American Printing House for the Blind, visually impaired guests can now navigate the KFC Yum! Center without assistance. GoodMaps technology transforms any smartphone into an audio guide that tells users exactly where they are in the venue and guides them — turn by turn, step by step — to elevators, restrooms, concession stands, arena seating areas and more. Download the GoodMaps Explore app for an Apple device or Android device today and easily navigate the KFC Yum! Center during your next event!

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Galt House Hotel and the PARC-operated garage located at the KFC Yum! Center are the two parking facilities that allow for direct interior access to the KFC Yum! Center and are ADA accessible. Patrons parking at the Galt House garage will enter the venue through use of the skywalk. Additional ADA accessible parking is available in a variety of parking garages, street lots, and on-street parking near the KFC Yum! Center. SENSORY INCLUSION

The KFC Yum! Center is certified sensory inclusive and has partnered with KultureCity to provide sensory bags or a dedicated sensory room for guests attending events. Please visit Fan Assist on the main concourse to check out a bag. Sensory bags include noise-canceling headphones, fidget tools, verbal cue cards, and weighted lap pads. They are available to all guests at the arena, who may feel overwhelmed by the environment.

The arena also has a sensory-friendly quiet space that will be available during all events for fans located behind section 112 on the main concourse.

RESTROOMS

Accessible restrooms are located throughout the Arena. Restrooms are accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. There are also accessible family restrooms located throughout the Arena.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Pets are not permitted at the KFC Yum! Center. Guests with a disability who are assisted by a service dog may bring the service dog as permitted by the ADA. Guests who require assistance from their service dog while at the arena are encouraged to call the box office at 502-690-9090 in advance to confirm seating locations or seat relocations.

BALLOON DROP

There will be a balloon drop during the close of the commencement ceremony. If you have a latex allergy, please alert a member of the WGU staff or Guest Services before the ceremony begins. They will assist you out of the arena prior to the balloon drop.



ABOUT

Commencement Weekend is a memorable experience for graduates and their loved ones to celebrate their academic achievement. We want our graduates to experience a joyful, rewarding, and distraction-free ceremony that recognizes their hard work and the sacrifices they have made to reach this point. WGU believes that mutually respectful participation by graduates and their guests is the best way to accomplish this shared intention. In preparation for Commencement, WGU has outlined a protocol. Your and your guests' adherence will ensure a positive experience for all.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES

All graduating students wear approved academic attire that includes a cap, gown, and tassel. The official regalia color is navy. We encourage all graduates to wear comfortable yet professional dress attire under their gowns rather than casual clothing. Master's degree graduates will need a hood specific to their degree. Graduates affiliated with an academic honor society may wear society pins or honor cords on their gowns. With the exception of WGU scholarship pins, leis, and corsages, graduates should not wear other items or decoration on their academic regalia.

Take into consideration the following if decorating your cap for commencement: WGU does not allow content on caps that is considered, in WGU's sole discretion, obscene, vulgar, defamatory, hateful, inappropriate, profane, or that might disregard another's copyright or third-party rights. All decorations must lay flat on the cap.

WGU COMMENCEMENT DECORUM POLICY

Please be advised any graduate or guest acting in a disruptive or disrespectful manner at WGU events, as determined by WGU in its sole discretion, may either not be allowed in the venue or may be escorted from the venue.

MILITARY

Graduates who indicate active-duty military or veteran status on their ceremony RSVP form will receive military honor cords at the Graduate Check-In area.
