CLIMATE PLEDGE ARENA POLICIES

GUEST SERVICES

Guest Services is available on the Main Concourse near Section 24, and in the Alaska Airlines Atrium on the Upper Concourse by the stairs and escalators on the West side.

EMT/FIRST AID

First Aid rooms are available on the Main and Upper Concourses. In the event of a medical emergency, please contact a Guest Services or Security team member for assistance. Trained Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) are available on site and can respond to any location in the arena.

GUEST SEATING

Seating is first-come, first-served. Guests should be seated with their cell phones on silent before the ceremony begins. Guests should remain in their seats during the entire ceremony as a courtesy to graduates and other guests.

The commencement venue allows photos and videos at the ceremony; however, we ask you to take photos from your seat rather than from the aisles due to fire and safety regulations and as a courtesy to other guests. WGU has hired a professional photographer for this event. Images of each graduate and the ceremony will be available online for purchase.

PARKING

Garage and street parking are available near Seattle Center.

CONCESSIONS

Concession options will be available for guests. Outside food and beverage (including alcoholic beverages) are strictly prohibited.

LOST CHILDREN

Lost children/individuals should be taken to the nearest usher or security guard. If you become separated from your child/guests, please proceed to Guest Services for further assistance.

NO SMOKING

Climate Pledge Arena is a smoke-free venue. Smoking is not permitted in the arena at any time. Additionally, electronic smoking devices are not permitted to be used on premises.

BAG POLICY

For the health and safety of all guests, and to expedite the entry process, Climate Pledge Arena requests that guests do not bring a bag to the arena.

If necessary, guests are permitted to bring a bag that fits within the following specifications:

- One clear bag that does not exceed 14"wx14"hx6"d in size
- Small clutches/purses/wallets that do not exceed 4.5"x 6.5" in size

Clear Bags larger than 4.5"x6.5" will be inspected. Medical bags and diaper bags are permitted, though we encourage you bring only what is needed. All medical and diaper bags will be searched and examined.

Graduates and guests are encouraged not to bring bags with them to the events.

CLIMATE PLEDGE ARENA POLICIES (CONT.)

MOTHERS' LOUNGE

Those who require a more private location in which to feed or pump may use the Virginia Mason Nursing Parents Room, located on the Southwest side of the Main Concourse, OR the Mamava Nursing Pod located on the Northeast side of the Main Concourse near Guest Services.

LOST AND FOUND

During an event, guests can report lost items or turn in found items to our Guest Services desk locations on the Main Concourse near Section 24 or on the Upper Concourse in the SW corner of the Alaska Airlines Atrium. To inquire about a lost item after an event, guests must send all lost and found item details to <u>lostandfound@</u> <u>climatepledgearena.com</u>.

ACCESSIBILITY

Please review the <u>Climate Pledge Arena Accessibility</u> <u>Guide</u> for more information on accessible services, programs and policies for our guests with disabilities.

Guests who require additional assistance because of a limitation in mobility can request a wheelchair transport from the entry doors to the Arena to their seating location.

A Guest Services Accessibility Assistant will escort guests to their seat, and pre-arrange a pick-up time if they choose to leave before the end of the event. This service is available on a first come, first served basis, and may be requested from any team member at the entry doors.

Please note that arena wheelchairs cannot be left with guests during the event. This service is unable to stop at merchandise, restrooms, or concessions. If you require the use of a wheelchair for the duration of the event, please contact Guest Services by emailing guestinfo@climatepledgearena.com.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

We highly encourage ticketed guests to pre-purchase a parking pass for one of our garages <u>HERE</u>.

All parking garages on Climate Pledge Arena's campus have ADA accessible parking spaces. Please note, however, that specific spaces, including accessible parking spaces, cannot be reserved when purchasing your pass.

Please contact the nearest on-site parking attendant upon arrival so that they may best assist you and accommodate your needs.

SENSORY INCLUSION

Complimentary sensory bags containing fidget tools and noise-cancelling headphones, feeling thermometer cards and identification cards that allow arena team members to recognize that the individual has a sensory need, are available for checkout at all Guest Services desk locations.

Guests may also visit the Sensory Room located on the Northeast side of the PitchBook Suite Level for guests who may feel overstimulated or overwhelmed at our events.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms can be found on each level of the arena. All-Gender & Family Restrooms are available on the Event Level, Main Concourse, Upper Concourse, and in the Space Needle Lounge. All restrooms are accessible and have changing tables.

CLIMATE PLEDGE ARENA POLICIES (CONT.)

SERVICE ANIMALS

Trained service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) are welcome at Climate Pledge Arena. Service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times, unless special circumstances exist, and are required to rest in the seating area of the guest with the disability, rather than the aisle.

Animal relief areas can be accessed by exiting through the Alaska Airlines Entry 8 on the Upper Concourse. Please see a Guest Services Representative for exit and re-entry.

BALLOON DROP

There will be a balloon drop during the close of the commencement ceremony. If you have a latex allergy, please alert a member of the WGU staff or Guest Services before the ceremony begins. They will assist you out of the arena prior to the balloon drop.

AFTER THE CEREMONY

- Guests will meet their graduates outside on the plaza.
- Graduates will receive a diploma cover at the end of the ceremony.

ABOUT

Commencement Weekend is a memorable experience for graduates and their loved ones to celebrate their academic achievement. We want our graduates to experience a joyful, rewarding, and distraction-free ceremony that recognizes their hard work and the sacrifices they have made to reach this point. WGU believes that mutually respectful participation by graduates and their guests is the best way to accomplish this shared intention. In preparation for Commencement, WGU has outlined a protocol. Your and your guests' adherence will ensure a positive experience for all.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES

All graduating students wear approved academic attire that includes a cap, gown, and tassel. The official regalia color is navy. We encourage all graduates to wear comfortable yet professional dress attire under their gowns rather than casual clothing. Master's degree graduates will need a hood specific to their degree. Graduates affiliated with an academic honor society may wear society pins or honor cords on their gowns. With the exception of WGU scholarship pins, leis, and corsages, graduates should not wear other items or decoration on their academic regalia.

Take into consideration the following if decorating your cap for commencement: WGU does not allow content on caps that is considered, in WGU's sole discretion, obscene, vulgar, defamatory, hateful, inappropriate, profane, or that might disregard another's copyright or third-party rights. All decorations must lay flat on the cap.

WGU COMMENCEMENT DECORUM POLICY

Please be advised any graduate or guest acting in a disruptive or disrespectful manner at WGU events, as determined by WGU in its sole discretion, may either not be allowed in the venue or may be escorted from the venue.

MILITARY

Graduates who indicate active-duty military or veteran status on their ceremony RSVP form will receive military honor cords at the Graduate Check-In area.
