
WGU (Serving Those Who Serve Our Country)

Affordability

Our programs are approved for all Veterans Affairs GI Bill® programs and Department of Defense Military Tuition Assistance. Because our tuition and fees are so low, military and veteran students often find all their costs covered by their government education benefits. WGU also offers scholarship opportunities for military students and their families. In 2022, WGU awarded more than \$1.75 million in scholarships to military-affiliated students.

Portability

WGU is fully accredited and offers online degree programs that follow students wherever they are stationed or deployed.

Flexibility

While WGU normally serves full-time students, part-time options are available for students using Military Tuition Assistance. And because WGU's programs are competency-based, students are able to move quickly through material they already know so they can focus on what they need to learn.

Individualized Support

In addition to our mentor-based faculty model, WGU supports military students through online peer-to-peer support groups. These groups are monitored by staff who are veterans themselves. And for students who must delay their studies for military duties, reassignment, and/or deployment, WGU has a special policy in place so they can take leave from their studies and return when they are ready.
