# Requirements

All submissions must be submitted using the Activity Log link on the Field Experience page. Student submissions must be their original work. Students must complete a total of 35 hours. The focus for this course is one or both spheres of care: wellness/disease prevention or regenerative/restorative care.

Your submission must be your original work. No more than a combined total of 30% of the submission and no more than a 10% match to any one individual source can be directly quoted or closely paraphrased from sources, even if cited correctly.

You must use the rubric to direct the creation of your submission because it provides detailed criteria that will be used to evaluate your work.

### **Logging Instructions**

- Discuss specific details of the education, resources, services, collaboration, communication, etc. the **NURSE** provides while engaging with patients during this direct care experience that promotes the chosen sphere of care.
- Select which sphere of care supported by the day's *nursing* activities.
- **ONLY** discuss rationale for the selected Sphere of Care: Describe the rationale (why) for the nursing interventions (education, resources, services, collaboration, communication, etc.) discussed above and how these work to achieve the chosen sphere of care.

### **Scoring Rubric**

Each required element in the assessment requirements **must have** a corresponding scoring aspect in the rubric. Any scores of **Not Evident** or **Approaching Competence** on **any** aspect will result in the learner failing the assessment. Learners should aim to pass their task within three submission attempts.
