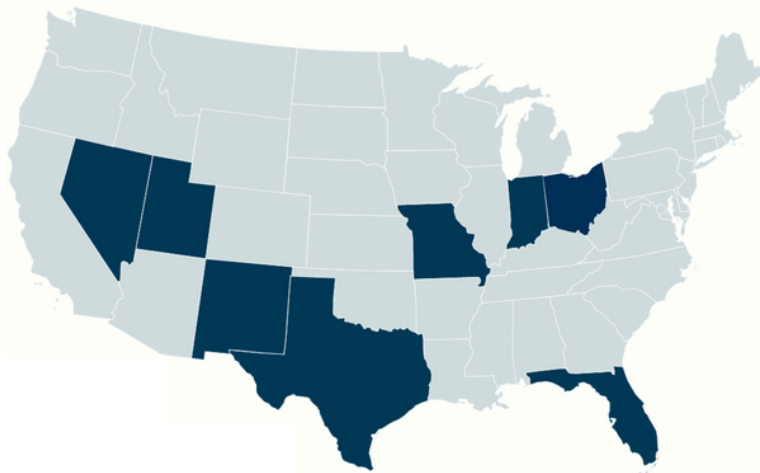




# BACHELOR OF SCIENCE, NURSING-PRELICENSURE

#### PART 1

**Clinical Nursing Curriculum**  
**Four 6-month terms**

## PREREQUISITES AND ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Score a minimum total score of 60%  
& a reading subtest score of at least 60%  
Two attempts allowed within 12 months

## COST

**Tuition for Pre-Nursing Term (1st Term)** \$6,430  
**Tuition for Clinical Nursing Terms (4 Terms)** \$7,616  
**Resource Fee** \$200 (paid each term)

**Background Check/Drug Screening** approx. \$100  
(one-time, subject to change per state requirements)  
**Uniforms** approx. \$150 (plus shipping, handling, and taxes)  
**Lab Kit Fees** approx. \$265

## START DATES

Start dates and deadlines are staggered and subject to change. Prelicensure programs begin at specific times, not the first of every month. Ask your WGU Enrollment Counselor about upcoming start dates.

**PLEASE NOTE:** This is not a bridge program (not an LVN to RN or LVN to BSN). WGU is not able to give direct credit for holding an LVN license. Students must complete all 10 prerequisite courses to qualify for the program.
