### **Institutional Authorization**

Students seeking to add an endorsement to their Louisiana teaching certificate should be aware of this information:

- Adding an Endorsement at the Same Grade Level (Secondary > Secondary) Louisiana Secondary Educators may add endorsements to their license by passing an additional Praxis exam in the new subject area.
- Adding an Endorsement at a New Grade Level (Elementary > Secondary) Louisiana Elementary, Middle Grades, or Special Education Educators may add secondary endorsements to their license by either passing both a Praxis pedagogy (PLT) exam AND the appropriate content exam, or by completing 30 credit hours in the new content area.
