Institutional Authorization

WGU is known in Missouri as "Western Governors University Missouri" or "WGU Missouri." WGU Missouri was established by <u>Executive Order 13-04</u> under Governor Jay Nixon on February 15, 2013. WGU is approved to operate online degree programs by the <u>Missouri Department of Higher Education</u>.

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Missouri will use one of three licensure pathways (reciprocity, approved, or direct) depending on their program.
