^{*}Advanced programs are for already licensed teachers who want to add an additional teaching area or field to their licenses (or a separate license for Educational Leadership). These programs are not intended for aspiring teachers seeking initial licensure.

^WGU's programs do not meet all the educational prerequisites to add a middle grades endorsement in science or mathematics to an existing Rhode Island license. Rhode Island Educators who want to add a middle grades (5-8) endorsement to an existing teaching certificate are required to complete a 45-hour practicum in a middle grades classroom. This practicum is not part of the WGU programs and must be arranged as part of the Teacher Work Sample at the end of the program.

Rhode Island educators who wish to add new certificate areas must complete specific coursework or an approved program, depending on their existing license and the type of license they wish to add. Details on adding an endorsement to a Rhode Island teaching license are available in the <u>licensure handbook</u>.
