Institutional Authorization

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Wyoming do so through the direct licensure pathway. Information on the different licensure pathways is available in the <u>licensure handbook</u>. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of Wyoming as well as information on applying using the direct licensure pathway can also be found in the <u>licensure handbook</u>.

Educational Prerequisites

WGU's education preparation programs do not meet all of the applicable educational prerequisites for professional licensure in Wyoming (for initial teacher licensure). WGU's programs meet the educational prerequisites for licensure except for this requirement: U.S. & Wyoming Constitution. Applicants may meet this requirement either through coursework or by passing the designated exams administered by the Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board. Those who complete the American Politics and U.S. Constitution course and the Survey of United States History course as part of their WGU program can submit course descriptions as evidence that these courses fulfill the U.S. Constitution requirement. WGU coursework does not cover the Wyoming Constitution requirement.
