Institutional Authorization

WGU is known in Ohio as “Western Governors University Ohio” or “WGU Ohio.” WGU Ohio was established on June 21, 2018. WGU is approved by the Ohio Department of Higher Education and offers its programs under [that authority](#).

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Ohio will use either the approved licensure pathway or the direct licensure pathway, depending on their program. Educational Prerequisites

WGU’s education preparation programs satisfy the applicable educational prerequisites for professional licensure in Ohio for the following licenses:

*Advanced programs are for already licensed teachers who want to add an additional teaching area or field to their licenses (or a separate license for Educational Leadership). These programs are not intended for aspiring teachers seeking initial licensure.

^ Principal Certification will be added at the same grade level of the existing Ohio teaching license.

WGU graduates of the BA Special Education and Elementary Education (Dual Licensure) program, the MAT Special Education program, or the BA Special Education (Mild to Moderate) program are eligible for a Two-Year Resident Educator license. However, in order to advance to the Five-Year Professional license in Ohio, applicants are required to have 9 semester hours in the teaching of reading and 3 semester hours in phonics. The Ohio Department of Education typically determines that WGU graduates have earned the equivalent of six semester hours in the teaching of reading. Graduates may need to complete additional semester hours in the teaching of reading prior to advancing their license. For more information on this requirement, please see [this link](#).

Educators holding current Ohio teaching licenses can add endorsements to their licenses in additional teaching areas by completing a state-approved teacher preparation program in the new teaching area and passing the Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) required by the Ohio Department of Education for that content area. The requirements to add an endorsement in Ohio are the same, whether you are adding an endorsement at a new grade level (Elementary to Secondary) or the same grade level (Secondary to Secondary).

The following programs are not available, as Ohio requires applicants for a Middle Childhood license to be eligible to license in two content areas in order for the license to be issued:

- *BS Mathematics Education (Middle Grades)*
- *MAT Mathematics Education (Middle Grades)*
- *MA Mathematics Education (Middle Grades)*
- *BS Science Education (Middle Grades)*
- *MA Science Education (Middle Grades)*
